

Before You Go

- Apply to Study Abroad program through OIP.
- Send a list of courses you are planning to take to the IAPA Faculty Director, Dr. Anya Bassett, for concentration pre-approval. Include syllabus (if available) and course description.

While Away

• Email Dr. Bassett if your course plan changes. Attach syllabus and course description for pre-approval.

After You Return

- Complete IAPA Study Abroad Concentration Credit Approval form and send via email to Dr Bassett, along with:
 - 1. Syllabi (Dr. Bassett may ask for more information, including papers, exams etc).
 - 2. Transcript from the Study Abroad institution
- ASK:
 - 1. Once the College has processed your study abroad credit, update your course plan to add study abroad courses for the IAPA concentration credit that Dr. Bassett has approved.
 - 2. Upload signed IAPA Study Abroad Concentration Credit Approval form.

NOTE

- Core courses (Gateway, Track Foundational, Junior Seminar, and Senior Capstone) must be taken at Brown.
- If going abroad for entire junior year, students must seek approval from the IAPA Concentration Advisor s to take a junior seminar abroad PRIOR to going abroad.
